



 - desolation of the land
 - a fierce army
 - c. Heavenly bodies affected**
 - d. The LORD'S army**

 - b. True repentance**
 - c. The glory of God**

The promise of the Holy Spirit for the Nation Israel

Ezekiel 37:14 – the means of Israel's restoration

Ezekiel 39:29 – the time of Israel's restoration

Joel 2:28-29 – the promise of the Holy Spirit

Zechariah 12:10 – the time of recognition of Messiah
