<u>Habakkuk</u>

Habakkuk: "to embrace" or "to wrestle"

<u>Date of writing</u>: Contemporary of Nahum,
Zephaniah, and Jeremiah placing him in the reigns of Josiah (640 - 609 BC) and
Jehoiakim (609 - 598 BC)
Babylon (the Chaldeans) was in power.

Historical Background: 1:2-4, 6-11

<u>Purpose</u>: To demonstrate the holiness and justness of God, and to encourage his people to live by faith.

Theme: Faith in God dispels all doubt.
