  - "Rest" Hebrews 3:11-4:11
    - Entry into the Promised Land (3:9-11)
    - More than the Promised Land
  - It is an ongoing expectation or hope for the people of God.
- 2. Let us fear lest any fail to reach it (4:1-10)
  - What is this rest He has promised?
    - The Promised Land
    - Rest of God
  - The call to fear
- 3. Let us strive to enter (4:11-13)
  - Strive or labor to enter.
    - Hard work
    - Faith
  - The Word of God is quick and powerful.
    - The Bible
    - The Son of God

  - Jesus our Great High Priest
  - Tempted like we are
- 5. Let us boldly draw near to the throne of grace (4:16)
  - Jesus our Great High Priest
  - Mercy and grace
