- 1:7-8 In Him we have redemption through His blood, the forgiveness of our trespasses, according to the riches of His grace, which He lavished on us.
- 1:11 Also we have obtained an inheritance ...
- 1:13-14 You were sealed in Him with the Holy Spirit of promise, who is given as a pledge of our inheritance.
- 1:18 I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened so that you will know what is the hope of His calling, what are the riches of the glory of His inheritance in the saints, ...
- 2:4-7 But God, being rich in mercy, ...made us alive together with Christ ... and raised us up ... and seated us with Him in the heavenly places in Christ Jesus, so that in the ages to come He might show the surpassing riches of His grace in kindness toward us in Christ Jesus.

5:8	<u>WALK</u> as children of light
5:15	Therefore, be careful how you <u>WALK</u> , not as unwise men but as wise
