

<u>MARK 14:1 – 31</u>

- Plot against Jesus' Life :1-2
- Anointing at Bethany :3–9
- Judas Plans to Betray Christ :10 11
- Passover Prepared and Celebrated :12 21
- Lord's Supper Instituted :22 26
- Desertion by the Apostles Predicted :27 31



Travels of the Savior during Passion Week (Mark)

- 11:1 near Jerusalem, to Bethphage & Bethany
- 11:11 into Jerusalem
 - into the temple
 - out to Bethany
- 11:12 out from Bethany (next day)
- 11:15 to Jerusalem
 - into the temple
- 11:19 out of the city (evening)
- 11:27 to Jerusalem (morning 11:20) – in the temple
- 13:1 out of the temple
- 13:3 Mount of Olives
- [14:1 After 2 Days]
- 14:3 Bethany







Mark 14:1 – 2

Man plans. God plans. Whose plans stand?

Mark 14:2 "Not during the feast ..."

Matthew 26:2

"You know that after 2 days is the Passover, and the Son of Man will be delivered up to be crucified."

God is sovereign. HIS PLANS STAND.

Anointing at Bethany (1)

Mark 14:3 – 9 Matthew 26:6 – 13 John 12:1 – 8 (Luke 7:36 – 50)

Similarities

- in Bethany
- anointing Jesus
- very costly oil of spikenard
- indignant response of onlookers
- commendation by Jesus

Anointing at Bethany (2)

Dissimilarities

Matthew, Mark

- immediately before
 Passover
- house of Simon the leper
- unnamed woman
- anointed His head
- alabaster flask of oil
- memorial

<u>John</u>

- 6 days before
 - Passover
- house of Martha,
 - Mary & Lazarus (?)
- Mary
- anointed His feet
- pound of oil
- (not mentioned)

(These are not irreconcilable differences.)

<u>Anointing of Jesus – Two Responses</u>

- vv. 4 5 Disciples INDIGNATION
 - 1. Gossiped
 - 2. Criticized
 - 3. Scolded
- vv. 6 9 The Lord Jesus Christ Himself DEFENDATION / COMMENDATION / MEMORIALIZATION
- v6. 1. Let her alone. Why do you trouble her?
- v6. 2. She has done a good work for Me.
- v8. She has done what she could. She has anointed My body for burial.
- v9. 3. Worldwide Memorial.
