## The Word of God and the Book of Zechariah

"Now in the fourth year of King Darius it came to pass that the word of the LORD came to Zechariah, on the fourth day of the ninth month 7:1

## ZECHARIAH: the man, 1:1

ZECHARIAH: (he whom) the LORD remembers (Zechariah's dad) BERECHIAH: (he whom) the LORD blesses (Zechariah's grandpa) IDDO: at the appointed time "The LORD will not forget His covenant promises to bless Israel at the appointed time." Zechariah Berechiah Isaiah, Hezekiah, Elijah, etc. Cf. hallelujah hallel (praise) u (let us) jah (Yahweh) ---Many "Zechariah"s in the Old Testament: 28 or 29 ---Matthew 23:35 may be a reference to the prophet/author Zechariah ---The only Minor Prophet who was also a priest (Major Prophets who were also priests: Jeremiah and Ezekiel)
