The Model Prayer

Matthew 6:9-13

--Context 6:5-8

- --How NOT to pray
 - --not like the hypocrites or the heathen
 - --not to be seen (or heard) by men
 - --not with vain repetitions (cf. The Rosary)

--How TO pray

- --in secret
- --to the Father
- --asking in faith
- --"in this manner" (v.9)

--The Prayer Proper

- --Christ's Primary Concerns
 - -- the Name of God
 - -- the Kingdom of God
 - --the Will of God
- --Other important concerns
 - --material provisions
 - --living as forgiven sinners
 - --deliverance from evil (the Evil One)

Note the word "Many"! These people have been active in "Christian" service: prayer, preaching, miracles, but the Lord Jesus Christ never knew them—they are fakes, hypocrites, false prophets—and He sends them away in judgment!
