Why do the accounts of Saul's death in I Samuel 31 and II Samuel 1 differ/contradict?

I Samuel 31 II Samuel 1

Wounded by archers No mention of archers

No mention of spear Saul seen leaning on spear

Saul tells <u>armorbearer</u> to Saul requests <u>Amalekite</u> to "finish" killing him "finish" killing him

Armorbearer refuses No mention of armorbearer

"Saul took a sword and fell on it." Not mentioned

"Armorbearer saw that Saul was dead." No mention of this

No mention of Amalekite Amalekite killed Saul

Armorbearer killed himself No mention of armorbearer
