2 Results of the Fall

1. Sin spread to all people (Romans 5:12)

2. Sin spread to all parts of the person (mind, emotion, will)
Spiritual Unwillingness
(John 5:39-40)
Spiritual Inability (John 6:44)

- 1. Election is divine: Mark 13:20; Eph. 1:4
- 2. Election is individual: John 10:3
- 3. It was before time began: Eph. 1:4
- 4. It is permanent and fixed: Acts 13:48; Rom. 8:28-30

Only the elect believe, no more, no less

5. Election is unconditional









Synergism

God elects those who first exercise faith in Jesus Christ.

Spiritually Well Spiritually Sick Spiritually Dead



Monergism

God elects people based on His sovereign good pleasure. Does God elect people because they believe in the Lord Jesus Christ,

<u>or</u>

does God elect people

in order that they will believe in Christ?

Does a person's faith cause election

<u>or</u>

is faith the **result** of election?

- 5. Election is unconditional
- Election is based on the foreknowledge of God
- 1 Peter 1:1 "...chosen ² according to the foreknowledge of God the Father..."

What does the word "foreknowledge" mean? $\pi \rho \acute{o} \gamma v ω \sigma \iota \varsigma$ prognosis \rightarrow foreknowledge

πρό *pro* means – before

γνωσις gnosis – knowledge

- $oid\alpha$ oida to know; to intellectually have information about something
- γινώσκω *ginoskw* to know someone intimately; in terms of a relationship.

πρόγνωσις prognosis

οἶδα oida

γινώσκω ginosko

- 5. Election is unconditional
- Election is based on the foreknowledge of God
- Election is not based on any giftedness or goodness in the sinner: 1 Cor. 1:26-29; 2 Tim. 1:9
- 6. Election is loving: Ephesians 1:4-5
