"and anyone to whom the Son wills to reveal Him" (Matthew 11:27)

The Son explains/exegetes the Father (John 1:18)

"For in Him all the fullness of Deity dwells in bodily form" (Col. 2:9)

"He is the image of the invisible God" (Col. 1:15)

"the exact representation of His nature" (Heb. 1:3)

"He who has seen Me has seen the Father" (John 14:9)


