A set of rules used to interpret the Bible

Literal

- O Every word has the same meaning it would have in normal usage
- OThere are metaphors, figures of speech etc....

A set of rules used to interpret the Bible

Grammatical

OThe meaning of the text is in the grammar of the text

A set of rules used to interpret the Bible

- **→** Historical
 - o Time
 - o Culture
 - o Geography
 - Language (Hebrew/Aramaic, Greek)

A set of rules used to interpret the Bible



Different genres have unique characteristics.

- 1. We are not obligated to obey the Mosaic Law
 - O Hebrews 7:12
 - Comparison of the contract of the contract

- 2. If a command/practice is repeated throughout Scripture, it is transferable to us
 - \circ Genesis 9:6 \rightarrow Matthew 26:52
 - O1 Corinthians 15:29?

- 3. If a command pertains to a non repeatable/unique circumstance, it is not transferred to us
 - OGenesis 6:14
 - OMatthew 21:1-3

- 4. If a command/practice pertains to a situation which has been revoked, then it is not transferred to us
 - O 1 Corinthians 14:5 with 1 Corinthians 13:8
 - OMark 16:17-18

- 5. If a command/practice is related to an eternal truth, it is transferred to us
 - OGenesis 9:6 "for in the image of God He made man."
 - O1 Timothy 2:12-13 "for it was Adam who was first created, and then Eve."
 - O Ephesians 5:22-24 "for...as Christ is the head of the church"

- If a command/practice is related to an eternal truth, it is transferred to us
 - O 1 Corinthians 11:2-16
 - Creation Order (7-9)
 - Angels (10)
 - Nature (13-15)
 - Church Practice (16)

- 6. If obeying a command/practice varies from culture to culture, and the command/practice is not related to an eternal truth, then it is not transferable
 - OHoly kiss (Ro 16:16; 1 Cor 16:20; 2 Cor 13:12; 1 Th 5:26; 1 Pt 5:14)
 - Ceclesiastes 9:8

- ✓ Every command is inspired and profitable!
