Psalm 1

- + * ¹ Blessed is the man that walketh not in the counsel of the ungodly, nor standeth in the way of sinners, nor sitteth in the seat of the scornful.
 - * ² But his delight is in the law of the LORD; and in his law doth he meditate day and night.
 - * ³ And he shall be like a tree planted by the rivers of water, that bringeth forth his fruit in his season; his leaf also shall not wither; and whatsoever he doeth shall prosper.
 - ⁴ The ungodly are not so: but are like the chaff which the wind driveth away.
 - ⁵ Therefore the ungodly shall not stand in the judgment, nor sinners in the congregation of the righteous.

⁶ For the LORD knoweth the way of the righteous: but the way of the ungodly shall perish.

Psalm 2:2-8

- ² When the wicked, even mine enemies and my foes, came upon me to eat up my flesh, they stumbled and fell.

- ³ Though an host should encamp against me, my heart shall not fear: though war should rise against me, in this will I be confident.
- * ⁴ One thing have I desired of the LORD, that will I seek after; that I may dwell in the house of the LORD all the days of my life, to behold the beauty of the LORD, and to enquire in his temple.
 - ⁵ For in the time of trouble he shall hide me in his pavilion: in the secret of his tabernacle shall he hide me; he shall set me up upon a rock.

 - * ⁹ Hide not thy face far from me; put not thy servant away in anger: thou hast been my help; leave me not, neither forsake me, O God of my salvation.

- ¹⁰ When my father and my mother forsake me, then the LORD will take me up.
- ¹¹ Teach me thy way, O LORD, and lead me in a plain path, because of mine enemies.
- ¹² Deliver me not over unto the will of mine enemies: for false witnesses are risen up against me, and such as breathe out cruelty.

- + * ⁵ I acknowledged my sin unto thee, and mine iniquity have I not hid. I said, I will confess my transgressions unto the LORD; and thou forgavest the iniquity of my sin. Selah.

- ⁶ For this shall every one that is godly pray unto thee in a time when thou mayest be found: surely in the floods of great waters they shall not come nigh unto him.
