 - The Holy Spirit will be in you (14:17)

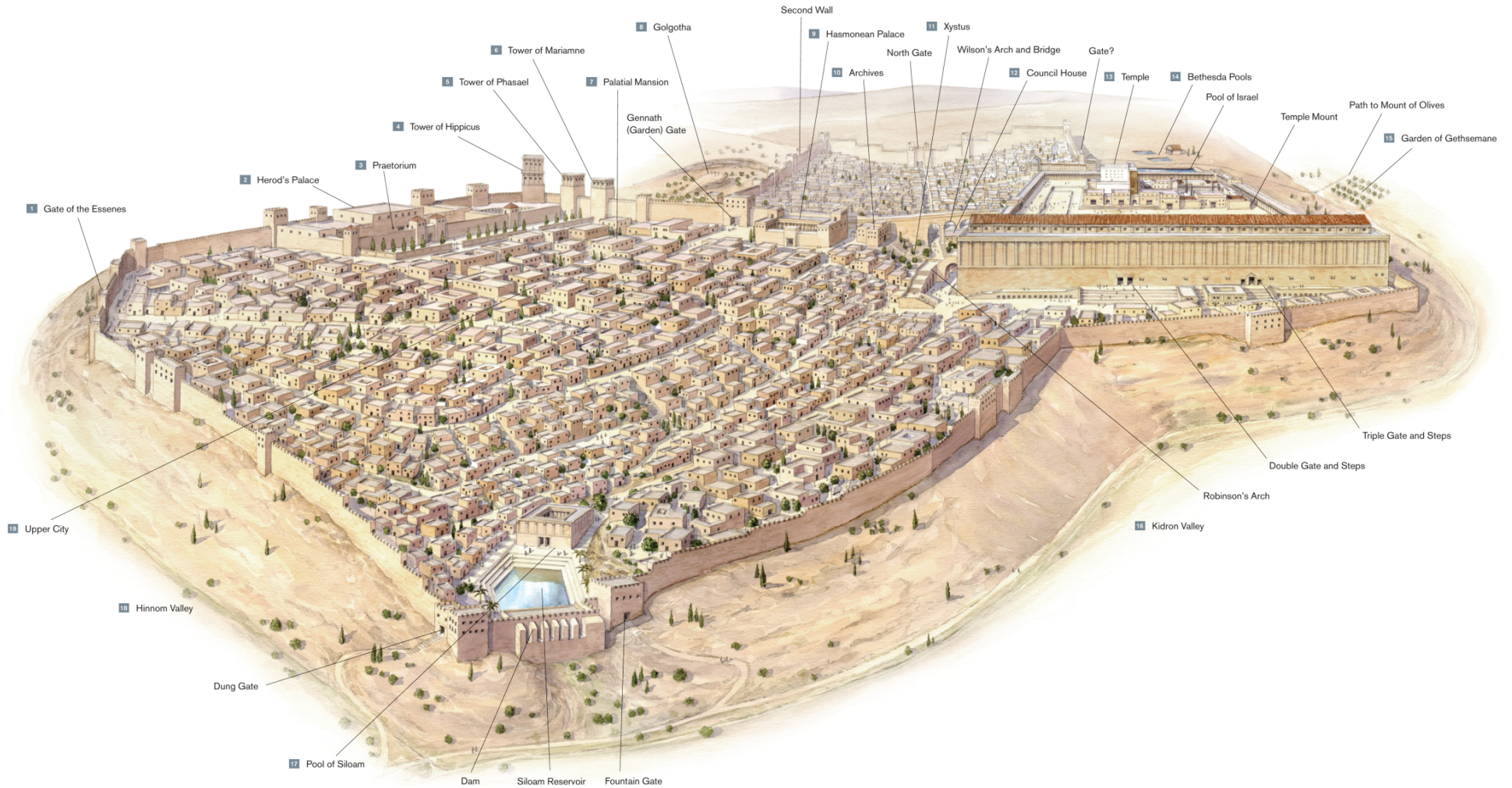
“Do not let your heart be troubled” (14:1)

3. His death and resurrection guarantee our eternal glory (14:18-20)
4. Loving obedience demonstrates our love for God (14:21-24)
5. The Holy Spirit guarantees the disciples accurately produce the New Testament (14:25-27)
