

The Farewell Discourse

- **→** In the Upper Room (13:1-14:31)
 - Jesus gives the disciples an example of loving humility (13:1-20)
 - Jesus identifies Judas as the betrayer (13:21-30)
 - Jesus predicts His imminent death (13:31-33)
 - Love one another with a perfect love (13:34-35)
 - Peter will deny Jesus 3 times (13:36-38)
 - Jesus comforts His disciples with truth (14)
- →On the way to the Garden (15:1-17:26)

Our relationship to Christ is to abide in Him (15:1-11)

- A. The Vine/Vinedresser/Branch Metaphor (15:1-2)
 - Jesus is the Vine
 - The Father is the Vinedresser
 - Fruitless branches represent professing believers who demonstrate their connection to Jesus is superficial
 - Fruitful branches represent genuine believers

- Our relationship to Christ is to abide in Him (15:1-11)
 - A. The Vine/Vinedresser/Branch Metaphor (15:1-2)
 - **B.** The Overarching command: Abide (15:3-8)
 - Fruitfulness is impossible apart from abiding (15:4)
 - Abiding results in fruitfulness (15:5)
 - Failure to abide results in final judgment (15:6)

 - C. Believers abide by faith in God's word (15:9-10)
 - Abiding results in loving obedience
 (1 John 2:5-6, 3:24, 4:12)

- II. Our relationship to those in the church is to love one another (15:12-17)
 - A. Christ demonstrates the intensity of His love by bearing God's wrath for your sin (15:12-15)
 - B. Christ's love for you is undeserved and through His sovereign choice (15:16-17)

- III. Our relationship to the World is to expect persecution (15:18-16:1-4)
 - A. The world hates and persecutes the truth (15:18-25)
 - B. The church responds to persecution by proclaiming the truth in the power of the Holy Spirit (15:26-27)
