

Background/Review

The Covenant made with Israel

- ♦ The Law give to Israel (Ex. 19-23)
- ♦ Israel accepts the covenant (Ex. 24)
- ♦ The Tabernacle Revealed (Ex. 25-31)
- ♦ Israel builds the Golden calf (Ex. 32)

The Covenant renewed with Israel

- ♦ God renews the covenant with Moses and Israel (Ex. 33-34)
- Israel accepts and builds the Tabernacle
- ♦ The LORD comes down to fill the Tabernacle

Preparation to Work (35: 1-35)

- ♦ Command to Obey the LORD's words (1-3)
 - Keep my Sabbaths as a sign
 - ♦ Keep the whole of the commandments (34:32)
 - Assemble the Tabernacle
- Materials and craftsmen collected
 - ♦ Building Materials A freewill offering (4-9, 20-29)
 - ♦ Craftsmen called to perform the work (10-19)
 - ♦ Bezaleel and Oholiab called (30-35)
- The result of the collection
 - Much more than needed was given

The LORD's Tabernacle

- ♦ The Outer Court of the Tabernacle
 - Altar of Burnt Offering
 - ♦ Bronze Basin
- ♦ The Tabernacle
 - ♦ The Holy Place
 - Golden Lampstand
 - ♦ Table of Shewbread
 - Altar of Incense
 - ♦ The Most Holy Place
 - ♦ The Ark of the Covenant

The Tabernacle and the Court (36:8-38, 38:9-20)

- ♦ The Tabernacle
 - ♦ Representation: God's dwelling (29:45-46, 40: 38)
 - Building Dimensions
 - ♦ 45 Ft. by 15 Ft. by 15 Ft.
- ♦ The Court Fence
 - Walls around the Tabernacle
 - ♦ 150 Ft by. 75 Ft. by 7.5 Ft.
 - ⋄ To Prevent Israel from approaching the Tabernacle
 - ♦ Court Gate
 - Only entrance to the court
 - Led to the Altar of Burnt Sacrifice

Altar of Burnt Offering (38:1-7)

- Materials: Acacia wood and overlaid with bronze
- ♦ Dimensions: 7.5 ft. by 7.5 ft. by 4.5 ft.
- Mobile: Rings on the corners and poles to carry
- Position: Directly in front of the entrance to the court
- ♦ Usage: Lev. 4: 27-35
 - Place of the burnt offering
 - Shows God's judgment on sin
 - Place where people were justified before the LORD
- Inadequacy of the altar
 - ♦ Not possible for a lamb, bull, or goat's blood to take away sin (Heb. 10: 4)

The Bronze Basin (38:8)

- ♦ Materials: Made of bronze
- Position: Between the Altar and the Tabernacle

- ♦ Usage: Ex. 30:17-21
 - Washing and Purification
 - ♦ To wash both hands and feet before entering (19)
 - ♦ To avoid death when entering the Tabernacle (21)
- Orange How do we approach God?
 - ♦ Only priests to enter the tabernacle (Num. 18:7 vs. 1 Pet. 2: 5-9)
 - ♦ Must wash before approaching God (Ex. 30:20 vs. Heb. 10:22)

The Golden Lampstand (37:17-24)

- Materials: Made of a single talent of Gold
- Position: Inside the Tabernacle The Holy Place
- Description: Single stem with three stems coming from each side
- Usage: To illuminate the Holy Place
 - ♦ To provide never ending candle light (Lev. 24: 2)
 - ⋄ To allow the priests to minister inside the tabernacle
- ♦ The LORD's illuminating Presence
 - ♦ I am the light of the World (John 8: 12)
 - ♦ He will be the light (Rev 22: 5)
 - ♦ His word is a lamp to our feet (Ps. 119: 105)

The Table of Shewbread (37:10-16)

- Materials: Acacia wood and overlaid with gold
- ♦ Dimensions: 3 ft. by 1.5 ft. by 2 ft.
- Mobile: Rings on the corners and poles to carry
- Position: Inside the Tabernacle The Holy Place
- ♦ Usage: Lev. 24:6-12
 - ♦ To hold the 12 loaves of bread and drink offering
 - To provide the priests with food
- Comparisons with Christ
 - ♦ I am the bread of Life (Jn. 6:48-54)
 - ♦ This is my body which is broken for you (1 Cor. 11: 24)
 - ♦ This is my blood which is poured out for you (Matt. 26: 28)

The Altar of Incense (37:25-29)

- Materials: Acacia wood and overlaid with gold
- ♦ Dimensions: 1.5 ft. by 1.5 ft. by 3 ft.
- Mobile: Rings on the corners and poles to carry
- Position: Directly in front of the veil to the Most Holy Place
- Usage: Ex. 30:6-10, 34-38
 - Priests to burn incense in the morning and evening
 - Output
 Holy Incense to be burned with fire from the Altar of Burnt Offering
- ♦ Incense which are the prayers of saints (Rev. 5:8, 8:3-5)
- ♦ Access to God (Ex. 30:6 Vs. Heb. 10:19)

The Ark of the Covenant (37: 1-9)

- Materials: Acacia wood and overlaid with gold
- ♦ Dimensions: 4 ft. by 2 ft. by 4.5 ft.
- Mobile: Rings on the corners and poles to carry
- Position: Inside the Most Holy Place
- ♦ Usage: Lev. 16:1-34
 - Ontained the Tablets of the Covenant, Aaron's Rod, and Manna
 - ♦ Where the Lord met with his people (Ex. 25:22)
 - Only ministered to once a year on the day of Atonement
- ♦ Result of the Day of Atonement Mercy
 - ♦ Contrast: Did it result in access to God? (Heb. 9:8,10:19, Rev. 5:6)

Conclusion

- The Tabernacle A Mobile Dwelling Place
 - Every part designed to be easily moved
 - ♦ A fulfillment of the promise (Ex. 34:8-9)
- God's presence in believers
 - ♦ With us always (Matt. 28:20)
 - ♦ Indwelt by the Holy Spirit (1 Cor. 1:22)
- Output
 How should we respond?
 - Look to the Savior who atoned for our sins
 - Pursue holiness in the power of the Holy Spirit
