- Arrival in the Wilderness of Sinai in the third month (19:1)
- Moses on the mountain 40 days (24:18)
- Moses on the mountain 40 days (34:28)
- The tabernacle set up on the first day of the first month of the second year (40:1)

#### God commands Exodus 40:1-5

<sup>1</sup>Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying, <sup>2</sup>"On the first day of the first month you shall set up the **tabernacle** of the tent of meeting. <sup>3</sup>You shall **place** the **ark** of the testimony there, and you shall screen off the **ark** with the veil. <sup>4</sup>Then you shall **bring** in the table and arrange what belongs on it; and you shall **bring** in the lampstand and mount its lamps. <sup>5</sup>You shall also set the gold altar of incense in front of the **ark** of the testimony, and **set** up the curtain for the doorway to the **tabernacle**.

- Items and locations
- The tabernacle is set up in a specific order
  - Tabernacle
  - Ark
  - Table
  - Lampstand
  - Gold altar
  - Altar of burnt offering
  - Laver
  - Courtyard

#### God commands Exodus 40:6-10

<sup>6</sup>And you shall **set** the **altar** of burnt offering in front of the doorway of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting. <sup>7</sup>Then you shall **set** the basin between the tent of meeting and the altar, and put water in it. <sup>8</sup>You shall also set up the courtyard all around and hang up the curtain for the gate of the courtyard. <sup>9</sup>Then you shall take the anointing oil and anoint the tabernacle and everything that is in it, and **consecrate** it and all its furnishings; and it shall be holy. <sup>10</sup>You shall also anoint the altar of burnt offering and all its utensils, and consecrate the altar, and the altar shall be most holy.

- The altar of burnt offering was near the entrance
- Think how many barriers there are between the people and the ark
- Items are anointed in the same order they are set up
- Everything in the tabernacle needed to be holy for proper worship

#### God commands Exodus 40:11-15

<sup>11</sup>And you shall **anoint** the basin and its stand, and **consecrate** it. <sup>12</sup>Then you shall **bring** Aaron and his sons to the doorway of the tent of meeting and wash them with water. <sup>13</sup>And you shall put the holy garments on Aaron and anoint him and consecrate him, so that he may serve as a priest to Me. <sup>14</sup>You shall also **bring** his sons and **put** tunics on them; <sup>15</sup>and you shall **anoint** them just as you have **anointed** their father, so that they may serve as priests to Me; and their anointing will qualify them for a permanent priesthood throughout their generations."

- Consecration of people
  - Aaron
  - His sons
- Process

- Moses' obedience

#### Moses obeys Exodus 40:16-20

<sup>16</sup>So Moses **did** *these things*; according to all that the LORD had commanded him, so he **did**. <sup>17</sup>Now in the first month of the second year, on the first *day* of the month, the **tabernacle** was erected. <sup>18</sup>Moses erected the tabernacle and laid its bases, and set up its boards, and **inserted** its bars, and **erected** its pillars. <sup>19</sup>And he spread the tent over the tabernacle and put the covering of the tent on top of it, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>20</sup>Then he took the testimony and **put** *it* into the ark, and attached the poles to the ark, and put the atoning cover on top of the ark.

- As the LORD had commanded
  - 16 Introduction?
  - 19 Tabernacle
  - 21 The ark

#### Moses obeys Exodus 40:21-24

<sup>21</sup>He then brought the ark into the tabernacle, and set up a veil for the covering, and screened off the ark of the testimony, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>22</sup>He also put the table in the tent of meeting on the north **side** of the tabernacle, outside the veil. <sup>23</sup>And he set the arrangement of bread in order on it before the LORD, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>24</sup>Then he placed the lampstand in the tent of meeting, opposite the table, on the south **side** of the tabernacle.

- Moses is obedient each step of the way
- There are two curtains and a gate protecting the ark
- God is a God of order

#### Moses obeys Exodus 40:25-29

<sup>25</sup>And he lighted the lamps before the LORD, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>26</sup>Then he placed the gold altar in the tent of meeting in front of the veil; <sup>27</sup>and he burned fragrant incense on it, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>28</sup>Then he set up the curtain for the doorway of the tabernacle. <sup>29</sup>And he set the altar of burnt offering *in front of* the doorway of the tabernacle of the tent of meeting, and offered on it the burnt offering and the meal offering, just as the LORD had commanded Moses.

- The bread and the lamps are "before the LORD"
- Both the holy of holies and the holy place are protected with a curtain

#### Moses obeys Exodus 40:30-33

<sup>30</sup>He placed the basin between the tent of meeting and the altar, and put water in it for washing. <sup>31</sup>From it Moses and Aaron and his sons washed their hands and their feet. <sup>32</sup>When they entered the tent of meeting, and when they approached the altar, they washed, just as the LORD had commanded Moses. <sup>33</sup>And he erected the courtyard all around the tabernacle and the altar, and hung up the curtain for the gate of the courtyard. So Moses finished the work.

- The washing of the priests
  - What their hands and feet
  - When when they entered
- The courtyard is the last thing set up
- The tabernacle is now ready to be consecrated

#### The cloud Exodus 40:34-38

<sup>34</sup>Then the **cloud** covered the **tent of** meeting, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. <sup>35</sup>And Moses was not able to enter the tent of meeting because the **cloud** had settled on it, and the glory of the LORD filled the tabernacle. <sup>36</sup>Throughout their journeys, whenever the **cloud** was taken up from over the **tabernacle**, the sons of Israel would set out; <sup>37</sup>but if the **cloud** was not taken up, then they did not set out until the day when it was taken up. <sup>38</sup>For throughout their journeys, the cloud of the LORD was on the **tabernacle** by day, and there was fire in it by night, in the sight of all the house of Israel.

- God's glory can prevent access
- The cloud didn't leave them for 40 years
- God directed their movements

### Summary

- The LORD told Moses when to set up the tabernacle
- God's commands are to be followed exactly
- For worship to be pure, the items of worship must be holy
- This mode of worship is the culmination of the law
- God's purpose is to dwell among His people
- The Israelites did not set out on their own initiative, but left when the cloud was taken up
