Likely an aged King of Israel

#### Hoping in the Lord's Deliverance

The Psalmist's situation: The opposition of evil men
Deliver me from the hand of the wicked (Vs. 4)

♦ The Psalmist's hope: Salvation

- ♦ I will take refuge in the Lord (vs. 1)
- ♦ I will rely on you as my deliverer (vs. 2)
- ♦ I will consider you as my fortress and protector (vs. 3)

♦ The cause of salvation: The Lord's righteousness

## Trusting in the Lord Deliverance

♦ Hope vs. Trust

- ♦ Hope: Expectation and anticipation of something future
- ♦ Trust: An inward reliance or conviction in the certainty of something

♦ A lifetime of trust

- ♦ My trust since my youth (vs. 5)
- ♦ My helper before I knew Him (vs. 6)
- $\diamond$  My fortress in times of distress (vs. 7)

♦ Trust overflowing into praise (vs. 8)

## Praying for the Lord's Deliverance

#### ♦ The opposition of evil men

- ♦ They are "watching for his life" (vs. 10, 13)
- ♦ They have formed a conspiracy to destroy him (vs. 10)
- ♦ They speak against him (vs. 10-11)

#### ♦ The Psalmist's request

- $\diamond$  Do not forsake me (vs. 9)
- $\diamond$  Be near to me and quickly come to help me (vs. 12)
- ♦ Give them the punishment and sentence they intended for me (vs. 13)

## Rejoicing in the Lord's Future Deliverance

- ♦ Rejoicing in the coming deliverance
  - ♦ I will praise you more and more (vs. 14)
  - ♦ I will proclaim your righteous deliverance (vs. 15-16)
  - ♦ I will remember and pass on your greatness to the next generation (vs. 17-18)

#### ♦ Praise for the Lord's works

- ♦ You will revive me again (vs. 20)
- ♦ You will increase my greatness and comfort me (vs. 21)
- ♦ You will display your faithfulness to me (vs. 22)
- ♦ You will redeem me and save me (vs. 23)
- ♦ You will answer my prayer (vs. 24)
