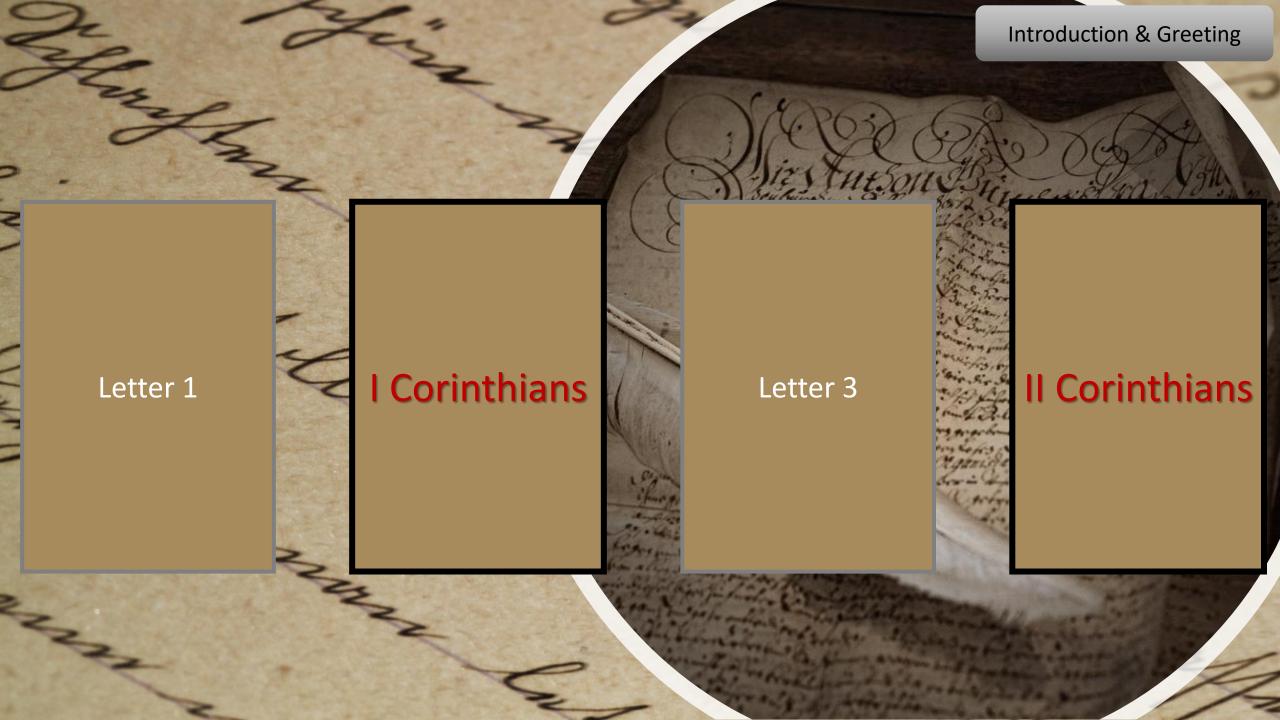

Historical Introduction

Church @ Corinth

- ✓ Paul's 2nd Missionary Journey (Acts 18:1)
- ✓ Met Priscilla and Aquila
- ✓ Mix of both Jews and Gentiles
- ✓ Established in ~A.D. 50

Letter to II Corinthians

- ✓ Written by Apostle Paul
- ✓ Written ~ A.D. later 55 or early 56
- ✓ Perhaps written from Philippi
