  - ♦ Grace in the believer's life produces fruit (1 Cor. 15:10, 2 Cor. 9: 8-9)

### Paul's 1<sup>st</sup> Exhortation

- ♦ The exhortation: "Open your hearts to us" (6:11-13, 7:2-3)
- ♦ The description of Paul's love (11-13)
  - Our heart is open wide
  - ♦ "I speak as to (my) children"
- ♦ The purpose of Paul's love (2 Cor. 11:2)
  - Paul's goal: Presenting them spotless before Christ
  - ♦ The danger: False apostles

#### Paul's 2<sup>nd</sup> Exhortation

- "Cleanse yourselves from defilement of body and spirit" (6:14-7:1)
- ♦ A foundational truth: Separate natures do not mix (Deut. 22:10, 6:14-16a)
  - Righteousness does not fellowship with darkness
  - Light does not commune with darkness
  - Christ has no harmony with the Devil
  - We have no portion with the lost world
  - God's temple has no agreement with idols
- ♦ Two applications of this truth (16b 7:1)
  - ♦ We are the temples of God corporally (1 Cor. 3:16)

## Paul's Joy in the Corinthians

- What is Godly Grief?
  - Understanding against whom you sinned (Ps. 51:4)
  - Understanding the nature of your sin
- ♦ What is Repentance?
  - "To think again or to change your mind"
  - ♦ A fruit of the Spirit's work (2 Tim. 2:25)
  - ⋄ To forsake your sin and obey the Lord
