to corrupt: "to destroy by means of corrupting"

"to bring into a worse state" "to lead astray"

"Bad company corrupts good morals" 1 Cor. 15:33

"Lay aside the old self which is being corrupted..." Eph. 4:22

a corrupting influence: a person or thing that influences us to devote LESS OF OUR LIFE to following and serving Christ.

a godly influence: a person or thing that influences us to devote MORE OF OUR LIFE to following and serving Christ.
