- A. Job's friends, Eliphaz, Bildad, and Zophar, come to mourn with him, not saying anything for "seven days and seven nights" (2:11-13).

- 17. Job (26-31). *Note: 29 - PAST

III. The advice given by Elihu (32-37). No response is given by Job, possibly because of the intervention of the Lord.

IV. The Lord's message to Job--mainly through questions (38-41, with only 40:3-5 containing words of Job).

V. Job's confession (42:1-6).

VI. Conclusion (42:7-17, giving the restoration of Job).
