John 1:1-5 <a> the Word / the LOGOS / the Creator / the life, the light, and the darkness

¹ In the beginning was the <u>Word</u>, and the <u>Word</u> was with God, and the <u>Word</u> was God. ² He was in the beginning with God. ³ All things came into being through Him, and apart from Him nothing came into being that has come into being. ⁴ In Him was <u>life</u>, and the <u>life</u> was the <u>light</u> of men. ⁵ The <u>light</u> shines in the darkness, and the darkness did not comprehend it.


John 1:6-8 Dohn the Baptist / the witness of the light

⁶ There came a man sent from God, whose name was John. ⁷ He came as a witness, to testify about the <u>light</u>, so that all might believe through him. ⁸ He was not the <u>light</u>, but *he came* to testify about the <u>light</u>.


John 1:9-13 + the true light / the Creator / receive · believe / the children of God

⁹ There was the <u>true light</u> which, coming into the world, enlightens every man. ¹⁰ He was in the world, and the world was made through Him, and the world did not know Him. ¹¹ He came to His own, and those who were His own did not receive Him. ¹² But as many as received Him, to them He gave the right to become <u>children of God</u>, *even* to those who <u>believe in His name</u>, ¹³ who were <u>born</u>, not of blood nor of the will of the flesh nor of the will of man, but <u>of God</u>.

John 1:14-18 → the Word / the LOGOS / flesh and glory / grace and truth / the only begotten God ¹⁴ And the Word became <u>flesh</u>, and dwelt among us, and we saw His <u>glory</u>, <u>glory</u> as of the only begotten from the Father, full of <u>grace and truth</u>. ¹⁵ John testified about Him and cried out, saying, "This was He of whom I said, 'He who comes after me has a higher rank than I, for He existed before me.'"¹⁶ For of His fullness we have all received, and <u>grace upon grace</u>. ¹⁷ For the Law was given through Moses; <u>grace</u> and truth were realized through Jesus Christ. ¹⁸ No one has seen God at any time; <u>the only begotten God</u> who is in the bosom of the Father, He has explained *Him*.




