Greek · ἕσχατος = ESCHATOS → "last" Greek · λόγος = LOGOS → "to speak" LOGOS = a word conceived & a word spoken ESCHATOS + LOGOS → "last" + "saying" to speak of last things · end times · things to come






Eschatology • the parts of the whole

The Seed Promise the victory The Messianic Promise Son of Man – Son of God Suffering Servant – Reigning King Savior – Ruler The Fulfillment of the Promise restoration – resurrection – salvation coming, presence and dominion of the Messiah judgment of the wicked kingdom – outpouring of the Spirit of God new covenant

Messiah (Hebrew) = the anointed one, the chosen one, "Christ" (Greek) Consecrating someone / setting them apart for a divinely appointed role.


