Greek · ἕσχατος = ESCHATOS → "last"
```

Greek · λόγος = LOGOS → "to speak"

LOGOS = a word conceived & a word spoken

```
ESCHATOS + LOGOS → "last" + "saying"

to speak of last things

to speak of end times

to speak of things to come
```

Eschatology → key historical developments

creation \cdot the fall \cdot the promise \rightarrow "the seed of the woman"

- Edenic "the seed" promise · a glorious victory
 - salvation & dominion

the covenants:

- 2 Noahic
- 4 Mosaic
- 5 Davidic
- 6 New

- the seed → no flood destruction
- 3 Abrahamic \cdot the seed \rightarrow land \cdot nation \cdot blessing
 - the Law → the Savior will save
 - the seed → the King will rule
 - the seed = Jesus Christ
 - the triumph · salvation & kingdom

eschatology → key events

- the rapture = "caught up"

 pre-trib/ beginning · mid-trib/ middle · post-trib/ ending
- 2 the resurrection

NT saints · OT saints · trib martyrs · millennial saints · the lost dead

- 3 the tribulation
 - preterist/ 70 AD · historicist/ church history · futurist/ things to come
- 4 the restoration of Israel to the land
- 5 the second coming

1st coming as the Savior · 2nd coming as the King

- 6 the kingdom
 - pre·millennial · a·millennial · post·millennial
- 7 the judgment
 - judgment seat of Christ · separation of sheep and goats · great white throne judgment
- 8 the new heavens and the new earth






The Works of God millennial views → pre-millennialism

- 1 a kingdom of the Messiah · King Jesus Christ
- 2 a kingdom with the capitol city in Zion · in Jerusalem
- 3 a kingdom with the temple · in Jerusalem
- 4 a kingdom under the terms of the New Covenant
- 5 a kingdom with mankind and glorified saints
- 6 a kingdom of the whole earth
- 7 a kingdom of righteousness
- 8 a kingdom of peace
- 9 a kingdom of earthly prosperity
- 10 a kingdom of life · the curse reduced
