



the failure → disobedience temptation lust sin


the judgment → death spiritual physical eternal



#### the description of the nature:

- 1 "lost" = spiritually · astray unto destruction
  - word: "wholly" + "destroy"
  - "lost" = to be deprived of something
  - "perish" = to be ruined completely
- 2 "blind" = spiritually · no visual perception
  - to be without spiritual perception
  - to be unable to understand God's truth
- **3** "dead" = spiritually · separated from life
  - to be without spiritual life
  - · to be incapable of making alive


the natural man old nature man after the fall all mankind

#### the walk of the nature:

- 1 total corruption · every part of man's nature is corrupted by sin and death
- **2 total alienation** · every part of man's nature is estranged from God
- **3 total hostility** · every part of man's nature is angry with God
- 4 total rebellion · every part of man's nature is defiant of the authority of God
- 5 total bondage · every part of man's nature is enslaved to sin and death

"total" = always every part  $\cdot$  not always evidenced  $\cdot$  not always expressed fully

- · forever ...




