the confession of sin – the righteousness of God (7, 16) the curse written in the Law of Moses (11) the mercy and forgiveness of God (9)

"Now therefore, our God, hear the prayer of Your servant, and his supplications, and for the Lord's sake cause Your face to shine on Your sanctuary, which is desolate.

O my God, incline Your ear and hear; open Your eyes and see our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name; for we do not present our supplications before You because of our righteous deeds, but because of Your great mercies.

O Lord, hear! O Lord, forgive! O Lord, listen and act! Do not delay for Your own sake, my God, for your city and Your people are called by your name" (Daniel 9:17-19).

Old Testament Eschatology → Daniel

- (24) Seventy weeks have been decreed for your people and your holy city, to finish the transgression, to make an end of sin, to make atonement for iniquity, to bring in everlasting righteousness, to seal up vision and prophecy, and to anoint the most holy *place*.
- (25) So you are to know and discern *that* from the issuing of a decree to restore and rebuild Jerusalem until Messiah the Prince *there will be* seven weeks and sixty-two weeks; it will be built again, with plaza and moat, even in times of distress.
- (26) Then after the sixty-two weeks the Messiah will be cut off and have nothing, and the people of the prince who is to come will destroy the city and the sanctuary. And its end will come with a flood; even to the end there will be war; desolations are determined.
- (27) And he will make a firm covenant with the many for one week, but in the middle of the week he will put a stop to sacrifice and grain offering; and on the wing of abominations will come one who makes desolate, even until a complete destruction, one that is decreed, is poured out on the one who makes desolate.



Old Testament Eschatology → Daniel

- to finish the "transgression" = the violation of law
 - (-) "finish" = to bring to an end → the final covering
- **to make an end of "sin"** = the act \cdot feeling \cdot thought of the forbidden
 - (−) "end" = to seal up → the final removal
- 3 to make atonement for "iniquity" = the act of the perverted
 - (-) "atonement" = to expiate → the final cleansing
- 4 to bring in everlasting "righteousness" = the demand of a standard
 - (+) "bring" = to cause to happen → the final presence
- to seal up "vision and prophecy" = the inspired revelation
 - (+) "end" = to seal up → the final completion
- 6 to anoint the most holy place = the temple or the Messiah
 - (+) "anoint" = to administer oil → the final blessing




New Testament Eschatology → **past view**
