the confession of sin – the righteousness of God (7, 16)

the curse written in the Law of Moses (11)

the mercy and forgiveness of God (9)

“Now therefore, our God, hear the prayer of Your servant, and his supplications, and for the Lord’s sake cause Your face to shine on Your sanctuary, which is desolate. O my God, incline Your ear and hear; open Your eyes and see our desolations, and the city which is called by Your name; for we do not present our supplications before You because of our righteous deeds, but because of Your great mercies. 

the Seventy Weeks of Daniel


*“Seventy weeks have been decreed

the **490** year decree of God
שבועים = SHAVUIM = weeks = sevens
70 weeks/sevens = $70 \times 7 = 490$ years

The Things to Come

Old Testament Eschatology → Daniel

God's decree for Israel and Jerusalem

- 1 to finish the “transgression” = the violation of law
(–) “finish” = to bring to an end → the final covering
- 2 to make an end of “sin” = the act · feeling · thought of the forbidden
(–) “end” = to seal up → the final removal
- 3 to make atonement for “iniquity” = the act of the perverted
(–) “atonement” = to expiate → the final cleansing
- 4 to bring in everlasting “righteousness” = the demand of a standard
(+) “bring” = to cause to happen → the final presence
- 5 to seal up “vision and prophecy” = the inspired revelation
(+) “end” = to seal up → the final completion
- 6 to anoint the most holy *place* = the temple or the Messiah
(+) “anoint” = to administer oil → the final blessing

But woe to those who are with child and to those who nurse babes in those days! But pray that your flight may not be in the winter, nor on a Sabbath; for then there will be a great tribulation, such as has not occurred since the beginning of the world until now, nor ever shall. And unless those days had been cut short, no life would have been saved; but for the sake of the elect those days shall be cut short.” – **Matthew 24:15-22**







New Testament Eschatology → past view





New Testament Eschatology → future view




