1) You Have Been Changed:

...from the old man to the new man

[4:21] *...you have been taught in Him...*

[4:22] *to put off the old man...*

....from the darkness to light

[5:7] *Therefore do not be partakers with them;*

[5:8] *for you were formerly darkness, but now you are light in the Lord;*

2) You Must Change Your Behavior:

...from lying to speaking truth (4:25)

...from anger to self-control (4:26-27)

...from stealing to honest work and giving (4:28)

...from unwholesome speech to edifying speech (4:29)

...from bitterness and wrath to forgiveness and love (4:31-5:2)

...from sexual immorality to thanksgiving (5:3-?)
