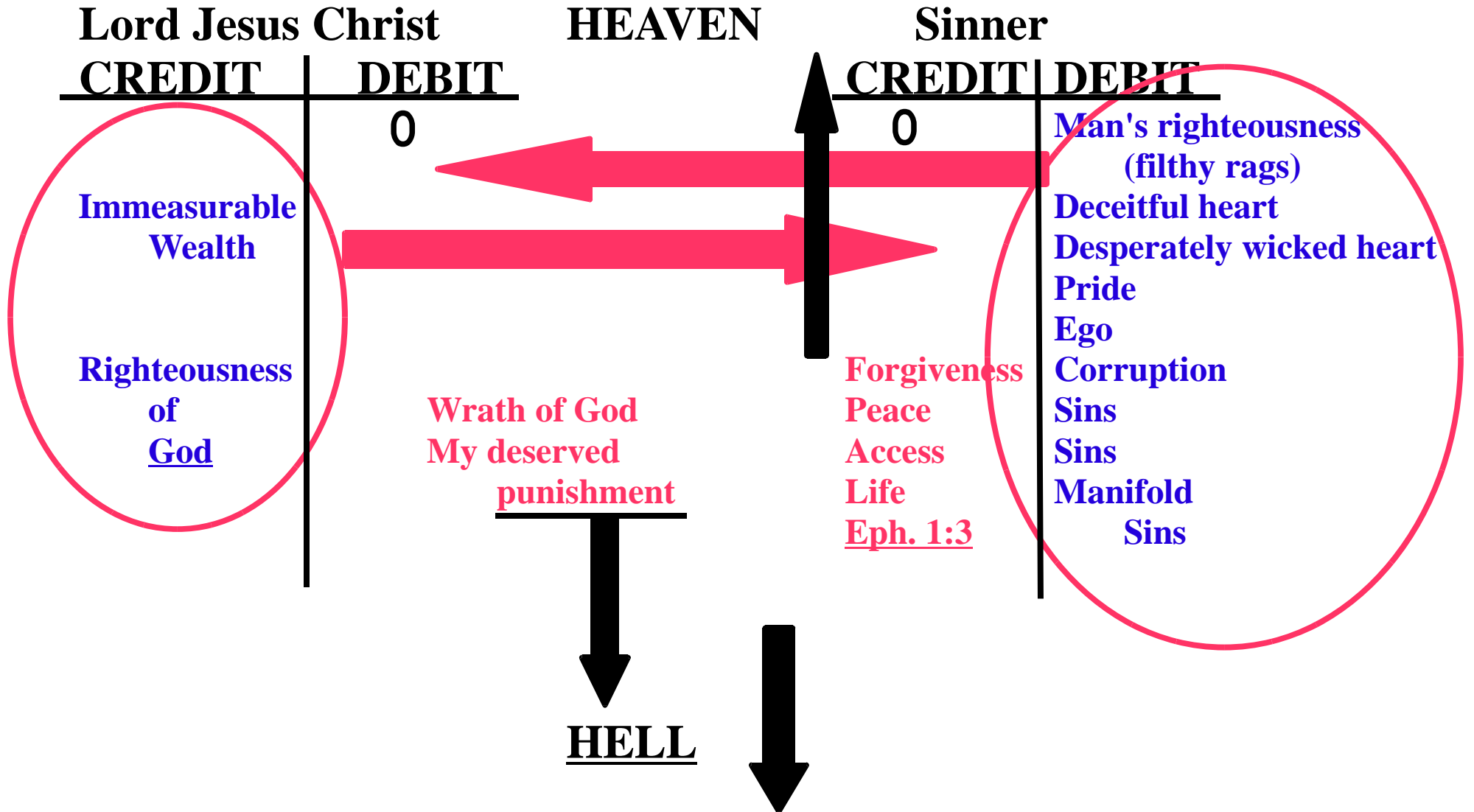
--metaphorical sense: “by a reckoning of characteristics or reasons, to take into account”
