

CHRISTOLOGY IN ZECHARIAH

1:11--"the Angel of the LORD" is the pre-incarnate Christ guarding Israel
Exodus 23:23, Isaiah 63:1-6

2:8-11—Messiah sent by the LORD to dwell in Zion Isa.61:1-3, Mal. 3:1-3

3:8—"My servant the BRANCH" is Messiah coming in humility (stem) and
power (stone) Isaiah 4:2; 11:1, Jeremiah 23:5

6:12-13--"Man whose name is the BRANCH" as Priest-King Ps. 2:6; 110:4

9:9-10--"Behold your King" coming in humility & peace Mat. 21:5, John 12:15

10:3—The LORD to visit His flock as Shepherd Ezekiel 34:11-19

11:4-14--"Feed the flock *prepared* for slaughter," He breaks the staffs (staves) of
beauty and bonds (or, grace and unity) Ezekiel 34:3

12:10--"Will look on Me Whom they have pierced" Isaiah 53:5, John 19:37,
Revelation 1:7

14:3-4—His feet will stand on the Mount of Olives, after which the mountain will
split Acts 1:11-12, Revelation 16:18-20

14:5—The LORD comes with all His holy ones Daniel 7:10, Matthew 16:27,
Jude 14, Revelation 19:11-14

14:9--"The LORD shall be king over all the earth" Psalm 2:6; 72:8-11,
Revelation 19:16

“DAY OF THE LORD” Zechariah 14:1

- Occurs 19 times in the Old Testament, all in prophetic books, and mostly in the Minor Prophets. 'The Day of the LORD' is the theme of the book of Joel.

- Occurs 4 times in the New Testament: Acts 2:20, I Thess. 5:2, II Thess. 2:2, II Peter 3:10

- Expresses a time of God's extreme wrath, which can refer to 1. A *near* future judgment, or 2. A *far* future judgment.

- Two Day of the LORD expressions are yet to be fulfilled:
 1. The end of Daniel's 70th week (ie, the Great Tribulation)
Joel 3:14, Malachi 4:5, I Thessalonians 5:2

 2. The end of the Millennium II Peter 3:10

- The Day of the LORD can occur
 - through Providential means Ezekiel 30:3

 - directly at the hand of God II Peter 3:10

Zechariah's God (Yahweh of hosts) is the God Who:

---is Creator of the universe

---reveals truth which is otherwise unknown

---reveals Himself, Who is otherwise unknown

---makes many promises, and keeps them all

---judges impenitent sinners

---forgives penitent sinners

---chastises and restores His people

---exercises grace

---executes judgment

---is the Lord of history: past, present, and future

in the grand scheme, and in the minute details

---exercises Supreme Authority and Power over

spiritual forces, nations, His chosen ones, salvation, EVERYTHING!

---demands authentic worship, in spirit and truth

---is HOLY, and Who calls His people to HOLINESS
