2. I will exalt my throne above the stars of heaven---

(above all angels)

3. I will sit on the mount . . . of the north---

(wanted to be Messiah)

4. I will ascend above the heights of the clouds---

(above God's glory)

5. I will be like the Most High

(wanted to become God Himself)

1. Brought down to Sheol, to the lowest recesses
of the Pit 14:15
2. Gazed at with pity and astonishment and
righteous indignation 14:16a
3. Accurately seen in his manifold wickedness

4. Deprived proper burial 14:18--20
