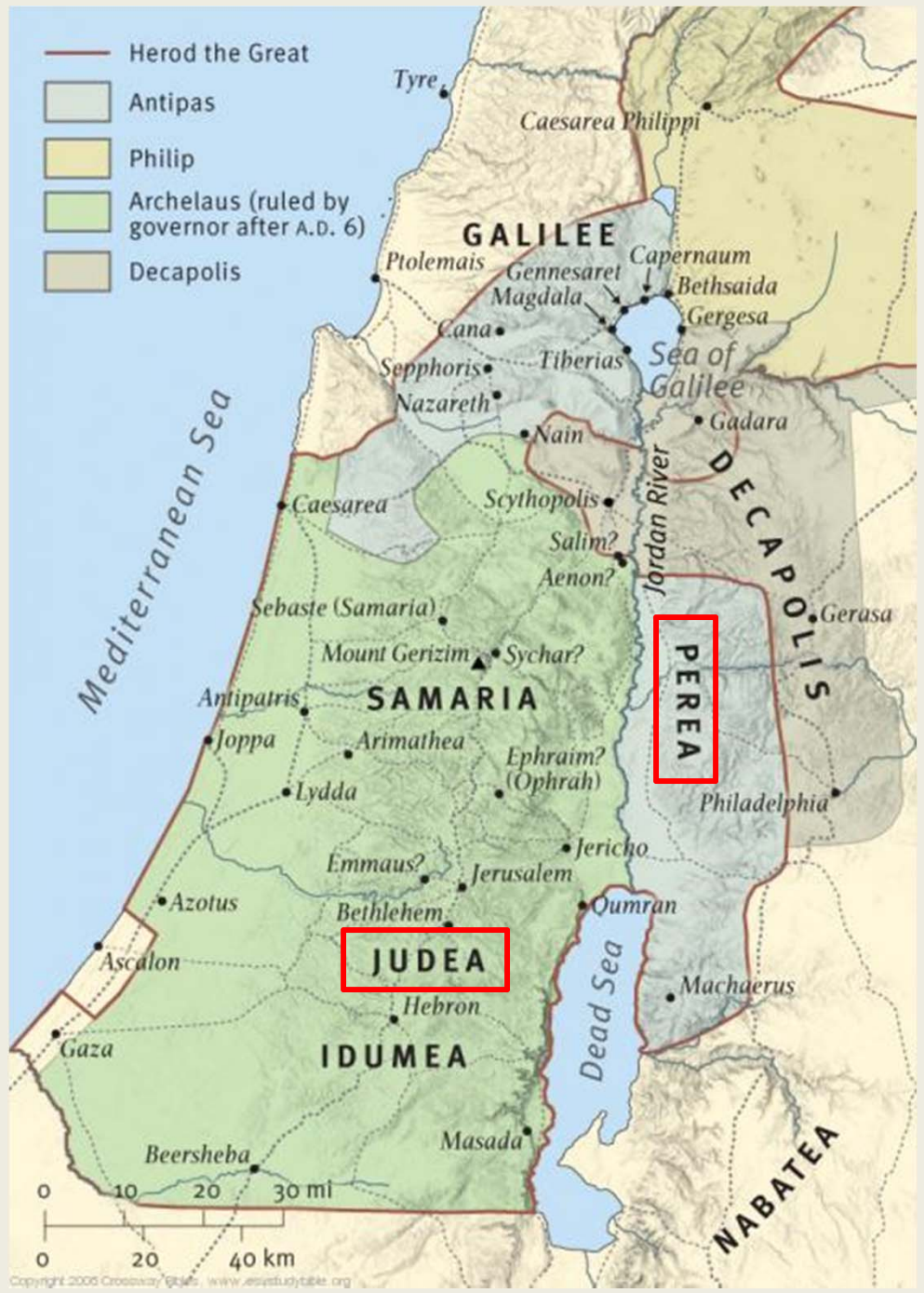

6 ingredients of repentance by Thomas Watson:

1. Sight of sin
 2. Sorrow for sin (Psalm 38:18)
 3. Confession of sin (Psalm 32:5)
 4. Shame for sin (Ezekiel 43:10)
 5. Hatred for sin (Ezekiel 36:31)
 6. Turning from sin (Ezekiel 14:6)
- 1 Thessalonians 1:9** ...you turned to God from idols to serve a living and true God...
