52:15 He shall sprinkle many nations

53:4 Surely He has borne our griefs
and carried our sorrows

:5 He was wounded for our transgressions
He was bruised for our iniquities
The chastisement for our peace was upon Him
and with His stripes we are healed

:6 the LORD has laid upon Him the iniquity of us all

:8 for the transgressions of My people He was stricken

(:9 *He had done no violence,
nor was any deceit found in His mouth*)

:10 His soul an offering for sin

:11 He shall bear their iniquities

:12 He bore the sins of many
and made intercession for the transgressors

**:1-5 Universal call; recognition of need,
necessity of faith**

:6-7 Urgency, necessity of repentance

**:8-11 Superiority of the LORD's thoughts
and ways in salvation; absolute
effectiveness of God's Word**

**:12-13 Creation rejoicing in the work of
the Redeemer God**

**Isaiah 53-55 A Picture of a Sainted Life
A Picture of Your Life**

**53 Salvation is accomplished in a person's
life (yours!) (mine!) through the
death of Christ**

**54 We rejoice as we begin to recognize and
appreciate our manifold spiritual
blessings in Christ**

**55 We offer the Truth of salvation only
through Christ, by means of faith
and repentance, to all the thirsty
(needy) people we encounter**
