Assignment 1

Psalm 42:11

Why art thou cast down, O my soul?
and why art thou disquieted within me?
hope thou in God:
for I shall yet praise him,
who is the health of my countenance,
and my God.

Psalm 45:7

Thou lovest righteousness,
and hatest wickedness:
therefore God, thy God,
hath anointed thee with the oil
of gladness above thy fellows.

Psalm 46:1-3

✦ * ¹ God is our refuge and strength,
a very present help in trouble.

- * ² Therefore will not we fear,
though the earth be removed,
and though the mountains be carried
into the midst of the sea;

Assignment 5

Psalm 51:10-16

- *¹² Restore unto me the joy of thy salvation;
and uphold me with thy free spirit.
- ¹³ Then will I teach transgressors thy ways;
and sinners shall be converted unto thee.
- ¹⁴ Deliver me from bloodguiltiness,
O God, thou God of my salvation:
and my tongue shall sing aloud
of thy righteousness.

- ¹⁵ O Lord, open thou my lips;
and my mouth
shall shew forth thy praise.
- ¹⁶ For thou desirest not sacrifice;
else would I give it:
thou delightest not in burnt offering.

Assignment 6
