#### Three Powers of Faith


- 1) The power to bring about Christian freedom apart from works

- 3) The power of marital union with Christ






### Checklist for good works of the body

# Philippians 2:5-8

Have this attitude in yourselves which was also in Christ Jesus, who although He existed in the form of God, did not regard equality with God a thing to be grasped, but emptied himself, taking the form of a bond-servant, and being made in the likeness of men. Being found in appearance as a man, He humbled himself by becoming obedient to the point of death, even death on a cross.

### The Most Important Paragraph (p. 45)

We conclude, therefore, that a Christian lives not in himself, but in Christ and in his neighbor. Otherwise he is not a Christian. He lives in Christ through faith, in his neighbor through love. By faith he is caught up beyond himself into God. By love he descends beneath himself into his neighbor. Yet he always remains in God and in his love, as Christ says in Jn 1:51, "Truly, truly, I say to you, you will see heaven opened, and the angels of God ascending and descending upon the Son of man."
