Assignment 1

Psalm 19:1

- ✦ The heavens are telling
of the glory of God;
And their expanse is declaring
the work of His hands.

Romans 1:18-20

- ¹⁸ For the wrath of God is revealed
from heaven against all ungodliness
and unrighteousness of men
who suppress the truth
in unrighteousness,
- ¹⁹ Because that which is known about God
is evident within them;
for God made it evident to them.
- ²⁰ For since the creation of the world
His invisible attributes,
His eternal power and divine nature,
have been clearly seen,
being understood
through what has been made,
so that they are without excuse.

Assignment 2

Isaiah 59:2

But your iniquities
have made a separation
between you and your God,
And your sins have hidden His face
from you so that He does not hear.

Habakkuk 1:13

Your eyes are too pure to approve evil,
And You can not look
on wickedness with favor.
Why do You look with favor
On those who deal treacherously?
Why are You silent

Those more righteous than they?

Assignment 7

2 Timothy 1:9-12

⁹ Who has saved us and called us
with a holy calling,
not according to our works,
but according to His own purpose
and grace which was granted us
in Christ Jesus from all eternity,

¹⁰ But now has been revealed
by the appearing of our Savior
Christ Jesus, who abolished death
and brought life and immortality
to light through the gospel,

¹¹ For which I was appointed
a preacher and an apostle and a teacher.

+ ¹² For this reason I also suffer these things,
but I am not ashamed;
for I know whom I have believed
and I am convinced that He is able
to guard what I have entrusted to Him
until that day.

Assignment 8

Titus 3:4-7

- ⁴ But when the kindness of God our Savior
and His love for mankind appeared,
- + ⁵ He saved us, not on the basis of deeds
which we have done in righteousness,
but according to His mercy,
by the washing of regeneration
and renewing by the Holy Spirit,
- ⁶ Whom He poured out upon us
richly through Jesus Christ our Savior,
- ⁷ So that being justified by His grace
we would be made heirs
according to the hope of eternal life.
