Philippians 1:1-4

- ^{1:1} Paul and Timotheus,

to all the saints in Christ Jesus
which are at Philippi,
with the bishops and deacons:
- ² Grace be unto you, and peace,
from God our Father,
and from the Lord Jesus Christ.
- + ³ I thank my God
upon every remembrance of you,
- ⁴ Always in every prayer of mine
for you all making request with joy,

Assignment 2

Philippians 1:5-8

- ⁵ For your fellowship in the gospel
from the first day until now;
- + ⁶ Being confident of this very thing,
that he which hath begun
a good work in you
will perform it until
the day of Jesus Christ:
- ⁷ Even as it is meet for me
to think this of you all,
because I have you in my heart;
inasmuch as both in my bonds,
and in the defence
and confirmation of the gospel,
ye all are partakers of my grace.
- ⁸ For God is my record,
how greatly I long after you all
in the bowels of Jesus Christ.

Assignment 3

Philippians 1:9-12

- ✦ ⁹ And this I pray, that your love may abound yet more and more in knowledge and in all judgment;
- ¹⁰ That ye may approve things that are excellent; that ye may be sincere and without offence till the day of Christ;
- ¹¹ Being filled with the fruits of righteousness, which are by Jesus Christ, unto the glory and praise of God.
- ¹² But I would ye should understand, brethren, that the things which happened unto me have fallen out rather unto the furtherance of the gospel;

Philippians 1:13-16

- ¹³ So that my bonds in Christ are manifest in all the palace, and in all other places;

Philippians 1:17-20

- 17 But the other of love,

which worship God in the spirit,

- ⁵ Circumcised the eighth day,

and the fellowship of his sufferings,
being made conformable unto his death;
- ¹¹ If by any means I might attain
unto the resurrection of the dead.

I am apprehended of Christ Jesus.

Philippians 3:13-16

- ¹³ Brethren, I count not myself
to have apprehended:
but this one thing I do,
forgetting those things which are behind,
and reaching forth
unto those things which are before,
- ✦ ¹⁴ I press toward the mark
for the prize of the high calling
of God in Christ Jesus.
- ¹⁵ Let us therefore, as many as be perfect,
be thus minded: and if in any thing
ye be otherwise minded,
God shall reveal even this unto you.
- ¹⁶ Nevertheless,
whereto we have already attained,
let us walk by the same rule,
let us mind the same thing.

so stand fast in the Lord,
my dearly beloved.

help those women which laboured
with me in the gospel,
with Clement also,

Philippians 4:4-7

- ✦ ⁴ Rejoice in the Lord always:
and again I say, Rejoice.
- ⁵ Let your moderation
be known unto all men.
The Lord is at hand.
- ⁶ Be careful for nothing;
but in every thing by prayer
and supplication with thanksgiving
let your requests
be made known unto God.
- ⁷ And the peace of God,
which passeth all understanding,
shall keep your hearts and minds
through Christ Jesus.

- ✦ ⁸ Finally, brethren,
whatsoever things are true,
whatsoever things are honest,

- ¹⁴ Notwithstanding ye have well done,
that ye did communicate
with my affliction.
- ¹⁵ Now ye Philippians know also,
that in the beginning of the gospel,
when I departed from Macedonia,
no church communicated with me
as concerning giving and receiving,
but ye only.

Philippians 4:16-19

- ¹⁶ For even in Thessalonica
ye sent once and again
unto my necessity.
- ¹⁷ Not because I desire a gift:
but I desire fruit
that may abound to your account.
- ¹⁸ But I have all, and abound:
I am full, having
received of Epaphroditus
the things which were sent from you,
an odour of a sweet smell,
a sacrifice acceptable,
wellpleasing to God.
- + ¹⁹ But my God shall supply all your need
according to his riches in glory
by Christ Jesus.

Philippians 4:20-23

- ²⁰ Now unto God and our Father
be glory for ever and ever. Amen.
- ²¹ Salute every saint in Christ Jesus.
The brethren which are with me
greet you.
- ²² All the saints salute you,
chiefly they that are
of Cæsar's household.
- + ²³ The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ
be with you all. Amen.
